North Sydney Council maintains 60 community noticeboards throughout the area as a free service to promote local community services and special events. Council gives priority to local community events and non-profit groups and services.

Instructions for applying to promote your community event:

- 1. Contact the Community Information Officer at North Sydney Council to book your space and make a note of the deadline.
- 2. Email a proof of the flyer to the Community Information Officer for review
- 3. If approved, deliver advised number (30 or 60) x A5 sized hard copies of flyers to the attention of the Community Information Officer either in person at Customer Service, 200 Miller Street, or by post to North Sydney Council, PO Box 12, North Sydney 2059.
- 4. <u>Remember</u> that it is your responsibility to make sure that hard copies of the flyers are delivered <u>before 12pm midday</u> on the closing date.

Note: Notices are placed the weekend following the closing date.
