

APPROVALS REQUIRED UNDER SECTION 68 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT, 1993



1. Use a building or temporary structure as a place of public entertainment or permit its use as a place of public entertainment.
2. Carry out stormwater drainage work.
3. Connect a private drain or sewer with a public drain or sewer under the control of a council or with a drain or sewer which connects with such a public drain or sewer.
4. For a fee or reward, transport waste over or under a public place.
5. Place waste in a public place.
6. Place a waste storage container in a public place.
7. Construct a temporary enclosure for the purpose of entertainment.
8. Swing or hoist goods across or over any part of the public road by means of a lift, hoist or tackle projecting over the footway.
9. Erect an advertising structure over a public road, or expose or allow to be exposed (whether for sale or otherwise) any article in or on or so as to overhang any part of the road or outside a shop window or doorway abutting the road, or hang an article beneath an awning over the road.
10. Extend a balcony, awning, sunblind, canopy, sun louvre, or similar structure or an essential service pipe beyond a road alignment.
11. Operate a public car park.
12. Install or operate amusement devices (within the meaning of *Construction Safety Act 1912*).
13. Operate an undertaker's business.
