Cremorne Reserve Pathway Project

There are approximately 3 kilometres of pathways within Cremorne Reserve that prior to the commencement of the pathway project are in a very poor to average condition.

The upgrading of pathways was rated as a priority as established by a community survey on completion of the development of the Cremorne Point Reserve Masterplan.





Other priorities in order of community weighting included:

1. New Lighting System - **Completed**
2. Pathway Improvements
3. Refurbish Toilet Block - **Completed**
4. Upgrade Park Furniture
5. Upgrade Robertsons Point Lookout
6. Upgrade Reserve Entranceways
(Bogota Ave, Milson Rd, Mosman Bay)
7. Pedestrian Intersection at Robertsons Point
8. Foreshore Access



Stage 1

- Council recently completed stage 1 works of the Cremorne Reserve Pathway Project.
- Stage 1 included the repair and reconstruction of approximately 400 metres of pathway on the eastern side of the reserve



Stage 2

- Council is now calling tenders for stage 2 works, which includes the pathway from Milson Road to Bogota Avenue
- The order of costs for stage 2 is estimated at \$750,000
- The project will commence this financial year, if the funding is available to match the tender prices received
- The detail of the design will be discussed at the forum's completion - 8pm to 9pm
