March	Asthma Weeds_– It is unclear whether the problem of “Asthma Weed” on the beach has been rectified. Another area of concern with this weed was identified – this is on the stone wall on the North eastern corner of Wycombe Rd and Harriette St.	<p>Council’s OSES Tree Maintenance Officer, has advised that Council does not own the land directly south of 3 & 5-7 Lower Wycombe Road. Council's Hayes Street Foreshore reserve is located south of 9 Hayes Street. This being the case control of the weeds should be directed to the appropriate land owners.</p> <p>Please find attached 3 maps indicating the property boundaries around Hayes Street foreshore. On the 2 contour maps Council's reserve is indicated in green.</p>
	2. Plants for the Planter-boxes in Hayes Street – The question was asked whether the North Sydney Council would supply plants, such as Port Wine Magnolias. The pots may need insulation to protect the new plants. It was suggested that the residents and or tenants of the adjacent properties be asked (in writing) to water these plants.
