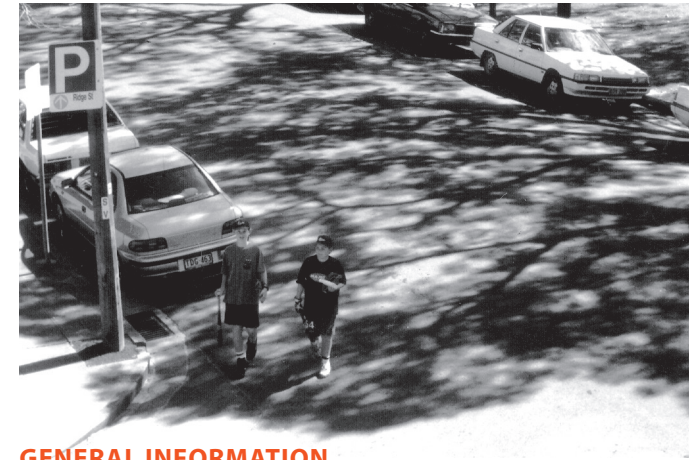

GENERAL INFORMATION

- A. Generally, residents of the North Sydney council area who do not have off-street parking available for vehicles at their residence may apply for a Resident Parking Permit provided that:
- the vehicle is registered in the applicant's name, to the applicant's North Sydney residential address or is a company or borrowed vehicle normally parked at that address
 - the vehicle is not a caravan, box or boat trailer etc.
 - the vehicle weighs less than three tonnes
- Permits for interstate registrations will not be renewed**
- B. In the case of a company or borrowed vehicle, a written authorisation from the company or owner stating that the applicant has complete private use of the vehicle and that it is usually parked overnight at his/her place of residence must be supplied. This letter must accompany your application to Council.
- C. Non-resident vehicle owners, tradespeople and hotel or hostel guests are not eligible for Resident Parking Permits.
- D. An annual fee is required for a Resident Parking Permit. The fee is reduced for applications received throughout the year. Please contact Council on 9936 8100 to ascertain fee at time of lodgement. Eligible pensioners pay 50% of the associated fee. To be eligible for the pensioner discount, proof of pensioner status must accompany each application, eg. a copy of your pension card.

RESIDENT PARKING PERMIT APPLICATION INFORMATION - (To be kept by you)

- E.** Holders of Resident Parking Permits who change their vehicle must notify the Council within seven days. A replacement permit will then be issued. A fee is payable for a replacement permit. Please contact Council on 9936 8100 to ascertain fee.
- F.** Residents living at the same dwelling may share a Resident Parking Permit provided all eligibility requirements are met. Only one vehicle at a time may use the permit and must park in the nominated Resident Parking Zone.
- G.** Contact Customer Service for replacement temporary permits.
- H.** North Sydney Council charges different fees for its resident parking permits based on the environmental impact of the vehicle. For details about these fees, please view Council's website at www.northsydney.nsw.gov.au or contact the Customer Service Centre on 9936 8100.

RESIDENT PARKING CHECKLIST

When applying for a Resident Parking Permit you must provide the following current documents:

a) Privately owned vehicle

current registration papers of the vehicle registered to the applicant's North Sydney address.
plus **ONE** proof of residential status document, listed below

b) Borrowed vehicle

the following 3 documents

- current registration papers of the vehicle;
- copy of the registered owners licence;
- a letter from the registered owner advising Council of the person who has possession of the vehicle, and a full description of it, detailing: make, type, year and exterior colour.
plus **TWO** proof of residential status document, listed below

c) Company vehicle

- letter on company letterhead advising Council of the person who has possession of the vehicle, borrowers address and full description of vehicle including make, model, year and colour of vehicle.

plus **TWO** proof of residential status document, listed below

Any of the previously mentioned proof of residency must have the same address as the address in your application.

d) Applicable Fee. Contact Council on 9936 8100 for appropriate fee;

e) For residents in three bedroom units applying for a second permit in Parking Zone B only, any one of the following:

- A copy of the strata title plan, including dimensioned unit floor plan
- A copy of the Council DA consent for the property
- A copy of the residential tenancy agreement which stipulates the number of bedrooms in the unit (tenants only)

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Resident parking permits are subject to Council policy. The Resident Parking Permit entitlements, as adopted by Council on 16 February 2009 are summarised below:

If the maximum entitlement is 2 and there is 1 parking space on the property then the entitlement is reduced to 1 resident parking permit. 1. I understand that the maximum number of permits issued per dwelling is subject to the entitlements outlined in Council's Resident Parking Permit Policy and that this number is reduced by any parking within the premises.
2. I have not leased, licensed, alienated, disposed of or permitted any other party to possess or use (for any purpose) any parking space which I am (or was) entitled to possess, or use in the premises.
3. I understand that I am not entitled to use this parking permit in the event that:
 - (i) I cease living in the residence; or
 - (ii) a parking space within the premises becomes **available** for use by me.
4. I will notify North Sydney Council if either of the events stated in paragraph 3 occur and will return the permit.
5. I understand that the parking permit issued to me must be affixed to the bottom left hand corner of the vehicle's front windscreen and that failure to do so renders the permit invalid.
6. I understand that a parking permit will only allow me to park the vehicle within nominated numbered areas authorised by signs bearing the words "AUTHORISED RESIDENTS VEHICLES EXCEPTED".
