Post meeting clarification – Council's Parks and Reserves team have been notified of the missing tree. Unfortunately, the optimal planting time has been missed this year and due to the pending summer heat, replanting will be postponed until next spring. At this time, a suitable tree surround will be investigated to better protect the tree in the future.

An update was requested on the reconstruction of the "Welcome to North Sydney" sign. Council's Project Manager confirmed the replacement sign is on target to be completed by Christmas.
