

Do I need to speak to Council about INSTALLING SOLAR/RENEWABLE ENERGY SYSTEMS?

North Sydney Council encourages the installation of renewable energy systems. In certain cases you will need to speak to the Council planning team, use the table below as a guide:

Call Council planners at first opportunity to seek guidance. A Development Application (DA) will be required for any orientation.

CHECK IF YOUR HOME IS HERITAGE-LISTED OR IN A HERITAGE CONSERVATION AREA:

- 1. Go to https://www.planningportal.nsw.gov.au/find-a-property
- 2. Enter your address and click on "Property Report" (green button on the right)
- 3. If applicable, heritage planning controls are listed on page 1 of the property report
- 4. Read through applicable State Environmental Planning controls to have an informed discussion with Council


THINKING ABOUT RENOVATING?

Include solar panels in your Development Application (DA) if you have a heritage-listed home, if your house is in a heritage conservation area, or if your solar system is over 10 kW in size.

Know where you can place your solar panels or solar hot water collector:

This drawing shows the roof plan and the relative position of a building to a street. You may place solar panels, solar roof tiles or solar collectors on any roof surface that is not visible from street frontages. Acceptable locations for solar systems are marked with a tick. For locations marked with an 'X', you will need to talk to Council's planning department.

Where your property is a corner block, you need to make sure that solar panels, solar roof tiles or solar collectors are not visible from either street. If you have a simple hip roof but no front facing roof plane (like in the diagram to the right) the solar panels, solar roof tiles or solar collectors panels should not be visible from the street.
