1. You must not commence any works until a CC has been issued, a Principal Certifier has been appointed and this form has been completed and submitted to Council.
2. The provisions of section 6.6 of the EP&A Act require you to give Council at least 2 days' notice of your intention to commence building works, once the Principal Certifier has been appointed.
3. You must ensure that Council, as the Principal Certifier, is informed 48 hours before each and every critical stage inspection is required.
4. Your list of mandatory critical stage inspections has been provided in the Principal Certifier acceptance correspondence sent to you by Council. If you have questions regarding inspections, please contact Council on 9936 8100.
