MR spoke to an AV presentation regarding changes to the Tunnel project, including:

- Acknowledgement of country and changes to the project
- The award of the Package 2 contract to Acciona (hence re-exhibit) and change from an immersed tube tunnel to an underground, bored tunnel produced by a Tunnel Boring Machine (TBM), circa 16m in diameter
- This means a reduction in harbourside and other construction sites and no coffer dams, with nearly all works happening underground to minimise disruptions.
- A modified EIS will be on exhibit in the next few weeks, with approval targeted for the end of 2023.
- The site layout of the Ridge St Compound, which will be constructed over the next 4 months, and the noise impact (which will be below ambient freeway noise levels).

The meeting also heard:

- The Ridge St compound will potentially stay until the end of 2028.
