## Frank Roberson- Elective Vehicle Charging

The need for community charging was discussed at length, with explanation on how they will work and constructive feedback given regarding the utilisation of parking spaces. Suggestions were made regarding EV car share, and working with development companies to embed these facilities within new builds. The rapid evolution of technology was broached, along with different and more sustainable forms of EV batteries.
