Warringah Freeway Upgrade- Noted

4. Council items

- Stairs from King George Street to Charlie Watts Park To update- Precinct requested Council to check the fence height on the eastern side of the stairway. Council's Manager Parks & Reserves has advised that the fence belongs to the railway authority and not Council. The Council is seeking further clarification on this item so this can be allocated to the relevant authority. Precinct notes.
- NYE 2023 Will not be ticketed- Council's NYE vantage points at Bradfield Park/Mary Booth Reserve,
 Lavender Bay Parklands and Blues Point Reserve will not be ticketed this year. The reserves will open in the
 morning and residents will be able to go in and out throughout the day until they are at capacity, after

 Bourke elected Deputy Mayor at their meeting on Monday 25 September 2023. Mayor Baker and Deputy
