		The CP Precinct expressed appreciation for council's efforts on rubbish and alcohol management during NYE celebration. Past observations note plastic bottles reaching the harbour.

		From MacCallum Pool towards the point, a popular picnic area, two recent issues have been observed: 1) Commercial picnic operators, 2) Late-night excessive noise.

Motorists have been observed driving at speed from the Ferry terminal up Milson Road. Does council have any guidance on how to mitigate speeding? Are speed bumps an option?
