PURPOSE:

The purpose of this report is to seek committee endorsement for the relocation of the Broughton Street Kirribilli loading zone to be moved closer to Crescent Place, Kirribilli.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

- The proposal to relocate the loading zone on Broughton Street aims to address concerns about delivery vehicles causing access issues for other road users when unloading in Crescent Place.
- In response to the concerns raised, Council undertook community consultation to move the existing loading zone closer to Crescent Place, Kirribilli.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT the Committee endorse the reallocation of kerb space on the eastern side of Broughton Street, Kirribilli at the following points north of the stop line from the intersection of Ennis Road and Broughton Street:

- (A) between 12 metres and 29 metres as: "No Stopping 6:30am-9:30am, 3:30pm-6:30pm Mon-Fri" and "1/2P 9:30am-3:30pm Mon-Fri, 8:30am-12:30pm Sat"; and
- (B) between 29 metres and 41.5 metres as: "No Stopping 6:30am-9:30am Mon-Fri", "Loading Zone 9:30-6pm Mon-Fri" and "1/2P 8:30am-12:30pm Sat".

Background

Council has received community concerns regarding access issues on Crescent Place, Kirribilli, where delivery vehicles undertaking loading activities for extended durations are obstructing other drivers from travelling along the street.

Council has also been advised that the Kirribilli Hotel is currently unable to use the existing loading zone for keg deliveries due to work health and safety concerns. As a result, kegs are being offloaded directly from Crescent Place, contributing to the ongoing access issues.

Crescent Place is a narrow road, approximately 4.5 metres wide, and is restricted to one-way eastbound vehicle movements. Due to its width, on-street parking is not permitted between Broughton Street and Humphrey Lane.

The Kirribilli Hotel has suggested that relocating the loading zone closer to Crescent Place would allow their delivery vehicles to use it safely while still receiving goods through the access on Crescent Place. This would eliminate the need to unload from Crescent Place and, in turn, resolve the associated access problems.

Report

To address the concerns raised by both the community and the Kirribilli Hotel, it is proposed to relocate the existing loading zone closer to Crescent Place. The proposed restriction would be "Loading Zone, 9:30am–6:00pm, Monday to Friday". Under NSW Road Rule 179(2), this restriction allows delivery drivers to stop for up to 30 minutes to undertake loading and unloading activities. While parking is not permitted during these times, vehicles may briefly stop to drop off or pick up passengers.

As part of this change, the current loading zone would be modified to "1/2P, 9:30am-3:30pm Monday to Friday, 8:30am-12:30pm Saturday". This allows drivers to park for up to 30 minutes during the time the restriction is in operation.

Existing "No Stopping" and "No Parking" restrictions on Crescent Place would remain unchanged.

This proposal is intended to accommodate the loading needs of the Kirribilli Hotel while providing an alternative for delivery vehicles to parking in the "No Parking" zone on Crescent Place for extended periods. By relocating the loading zone, the proposal would help improve access for all road users.

Following community consultation, Council received full support for the proposed changes.

Consultation Requirements

Community engagement has occurred in accordance with Council's Community Engagement Protocol. The detail of this report provides the outcomes from the engagement for Council to consider prior to adoption.

Public Consultation

Community consultation of the proposal took place between 20 March and 15 May 2025. 69 letters were delivered to properties located within 50 metres of the extent of the proposal. Further, an online survey was available through Council's "Have Your Say" webpage.

2 responses were received, both being from outside the survey area.

The results indicate 100% support from the submissions received for the proposal.
