1. Items for discussion

- i. As BE advised previously that housing is not a suitable topic for the Aug meeting and NM as the keynote speaker will not work. NM is Manager of Strategic Planning at Council. He suggested Tunks Park be the major topic for the August GM, supporting AC'c proposal recently submitted to Council, plus continuing to advocate for improved drainage along the northern perimeter. He will approach PW to be the speaker.
- ii. JB prepared a draft proposal for the integration of public transport into the Western Harbour Tunnel. Proposes raising it with the CPC Infrastructure Sub-Committee with a view to raising a motion at the CPC meeting asking council to support. Committee supports this.
- iii. AS: Revised Draft Delivery Program 2025-29 a motion was passed at a recent CPC meeting asking for a 6-month extension on community consultation. When we have clarity, we may include it in the August GM agenda.

- i. BE proposed that now is the time to act on Tunks Park actions as above. AA: Sandstone is cost effective. SR: Drainage of the northern boggy areas of the park is also important and needs to be rectified.
- ii. BE: Stratford Street, Cammeray carry forward to next committee meeting

- iii. BE: Rosalind Street at Miller Street new pedestrian crossings carry forward to next meeting
- iv. BE: Birdnet update by HM carry forward.

- ii. AS: Pedestrian, Traffic & the Road to ruin (and specifically the impacts on Cammeray Village) nothing new to report.
