

ROAD CLOSURES

The Sydney Marathon starting area is returning to North Sydney Oval (St Leonards Park) this year, its original starting location from the 2000 Olympic Games. As such, road closures will be significant and vehicle movements around the course will be limited for majority of the day. Residents are urged to avoid unnecessary travel on event day as extensive detours will be in place with longer travel times.

- » Roads around the start area in North Sydney will be closed between 2am – 12midday. On Saturday, 30 August part of Ridge St will close from 7am.
- » Major roads and cycleways will be closed between 3am–4pm in the Sydney CBD, The Rocks, Millers Point, Barangaroo, Pyrmont, Darlinghurst, Moore Park, Centennial Park and Kingsford.
- » The Sydney Harbour Bridge, Cahill Expressway, and Western Distributor will be closed in both directions from 3am – 11am.
- » Major roads will be closed from Sydney Opera House in the city through Darlinghurst to Kingsford, including Macquarie St, College St, Park St, and sections of Oxford St, Flinders St, and Anzac Pde between 4am–4pm.
- » The Sydney Harbour Tunnel, Eastern Distributor, Victoria Rd, and The Cross City Tunnel remain open; however, delays are expected. The Cross City Tunnel will be toll-free from 5am–4.30pm.
- » **Saturday 30 August:** Some CBD roads (Macquarie St, Art Galley Rd, Mrs Macquaries Rd, College St) will be closed for the TCS Mini Marathon 5km between 2am–10am.

SPECIAL EVENT CLEARWAYS



- » Special event clearways will be in effect on roads in North Sydney between 12am (midnight) – 2pm. Some clearways will be in effect from 6am Saturday 30 August on sections of Ridge St and Miller St. Clearways in other areas along the course will be in effect until 4pm.
- » Clearways are strict no-parking zones and apply to local residents and TfNSW Mobility Scheme Permit holders. To avoid being towed, please do not leave any vehicles, including motor vehicles, trailers, and boats, parked in clearways. Clearways are in place to clear the course of vehicles for the safety of participants.
- » Check the yellow signage carefully when parking on Sunday as well as the nights before – vehicles left in clearways will be towed, and a fee applies.
- » If your vehicle is towed, call the Traffic Information Line on 132 701 to find its new location.

It joins the ranks of the AbbottWMMs alongside the Boston Marathon presented by Bank of America, TCS London Marathon, Bank of America Chicago Marathon, BMW Berlin Marathon, Tokyo Marathon, and the TCS New York City Marathon as part of the greatest marathon series in the world.

The event carries the legacy of the Sydney 2000 Olympic Games, designed to promote physical fitness, community health, charity fundraising, and Sydney tourism.

You may experience slightly more noise than usual from event related activities, including early morning broadcast helicopters, course entertainment, and general event activities. Event organisers endeavour to keep noise to a minimum.



ROAD CLOSURES ARE SIGNIFICANT THIS
YEAR WITH MAJOR DETOURS IN PLACE.
VEHICLE ACCESS TO PROPERTIES ALONG
AND AROUND THE COURSE WILL BE LIMITED
SO PLAN AHEAD AND FOLLOW THESE TIPS.

- » Don't Drive. Leave your car at home. Avoid non-essential travel.
- » Move your vehicle out of special event clearways and road closures. Scan the QR code for an alternate parking reimbursement form.
- » Plan your trip - if you must drive, be aware of road closure times and locations. For real-time updates on traffic conditions visit [livetraffic.com](https://www.livetraffic.com)
- » Use public transport. Extra services will run. Note: buses and light rail services will be affected, details at transport.nsw.info
- » Check parking signage - avoid being towed from streets with special event clearways. If you need to access your vehicle during the event, park outside of the road closures and clearway locations.
