#### **BACKGROUND**

At its meeting held 14 October 2013, Council resolved to remove the limit on citizen member positions numbers available per Reference and Working Group.

The Sustainable Transport Reference Group Charter provides the following eligibility requirements:

- a) individuals North Sydney residents; and
- b) representatives from community organisations/groups working with the community in North Sydney, with a maximum of two representatives from any one group.

The Reference Group Charters have not been reviewed for some time and a review is proposed in 2023.

### **DETAIL**

Mr Tony Stanley has applied to be a member of the Sustainable Transport Reference Group. He is an active member of Bicycle NSW and Bicycle North, and is a very experienced utility cyclist who has lived and worked in numerous countries and used a bicycle for transport. Mr Stanley is a daily rider in North Sydney, and transports his children by bike.
