5.1. Alexander Street, Crows Nest - Proposed Parking Changes

The purpose of this report is to seek committee endorsement for the installation of 15-minute parking restriction in Alexander Street, Crows Nest.

- Council has received concerns about limited parking availability on Alexander Street in Crows Nest for Mobility Parking Scheme permit holders accessing the shops in the area.
- On street dedicated disability parking spaces in commercial areas tends to result in a single vehicle parked all day and provides limited improvement to accessibility. For this reason, Council does not support dedicated disability parking spaces in commercial areas.
- In response to the concerns raised, Council is planning to install two (2) "No Stopping 6:30am-9:30am 3:30pm-6:30pm Mon-Fri" and "1/4P 9:30am-3:30pm Mon-Fri, 8:30am-12:30pm Sat" spaces.

RECOMMENDATION:
