PURPOSE:

The purpose of this report is to seek Council's endorsement of the recommended winners of the North Sydney Community Awards 2025.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

- North Sydney Council administers an annual Community Awards program to formally recognise individuals and organisations that have demonstrated exceptional contributions to the wellbeing of the community and the enhancement of the local environment within the North Sydney Local Government Area.
- The awards program is a small but important way in which Council acknowledges and celebrates the enormous contribution that grassroots volunteers make to build and enhance community capacity, resilience and spirit in North Sydney.
- The nomination period for the 2025 awards commenced on 3 February and concluded on 7 March 2025.
- The Community Awards Selection Panel, comprising the Mayor and representatives from key Council departments, convened on 18 March 2025 to determine the recipients of the 2025 awards.
- This report seeks Council's endorsement of the panel's recommended award winners.

Background

North Sydney Council delivers an annual Community Awards program to acknowledge individuals and groups who have made exceptional contributions throughout the year to community wellbeing, environmental sustainability, and civic spirit within the North Sydney area.

The program is a small but important way in which Council acknowledges and celebrates the enormous and rich contribution that local volunteers make to build and enhance community capacity, resilience and spirit in the North Sydney community.

In 2020, Council introduced a refreshed format for the Community Awards to better reflect the distinctive character of the North Sydney community, celebrate the significance of all nominations received, and emphasise the vital role of grassroots volunteerism. The updated program also includes the introduction of new award categories.

Report

Five award categories formed part of the nomination process for a contribution by an individual or community group within the last 12 months (or for more than 20 years in the Living Legend Award category). The five award categories include:

Community Builder

This person or group is the glue that makes the North Sydney community stronger, together.

Eco Warrior

This person or group has made an outstanding contribution to making North Sydney cleaner and greener.

Living Legend

This person has served the North Sydney community for more than 20 years and is an inspiration to others.

Next Generation

This young person or group of young people have made an outstanding contribution to the North Sydney community and are an inspiration to others. Nominees must be 24 years and under.

Trailblazer

This person or group of people are bold innovators, driving positive impact within the North Sydney community.

The awards nomination process was widely publicised throughout the community via multiple channels to raise awareness and encourage community participation:
