BACKGROUND

Contract 35/2018 was awarded to Bermagui Constructions P/L for undertaking of remedial works to the Duncan Thompson Stand at North Sydney Oval, including repair of deteriorated structural columns, balustrades and timberwork, as well as upgrading fire services to meet current standards. Works commenced onsite in July 2018 and have been completed to a high standard - excepting the fire services upgrade - which was placed on hold due to a required change in methodology that arose following detailed site investigations.
