Pursuant to Section 4.56 of the Act notice is hereby given of the determination by the consent authority of your request for a modification to Development Consent No. 102/16 and registered in Council's records as Application No. 102/16/8 relating to the land described as 3 East Crescent Street, McMahons Point.

Your request for the modification of the Development Consent as set out in Notice of Determination dated 21 September 2016, has been determined in the following manner: -

1. Modify Condition G16 to read as follows:

Landscaping

G16. The landscaping shown in the approved landscape plans indicated in Condition A4 of this consent must be completed prior to the issue of the Occupation Certificate for the whole of the building.

(Reason: To ensure compliance)

Assessment Act 1979 (as amended), and found to be generally acceptable in the site circumstances.	Reason for approval:	The proposed modifications have been assessed against Section 4.56 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 (as amended), and found to be generally acceptable in the site circumstances.

The proposed modification does not seek a change to the approved landscaping. The proposed modification only relates to the timing of the landscaping works to permit occupation of the building prior to the completion of all approved landscaping works.

Consequently, the Section 4.56 application is considered to be reasonable in the circumstances and it is recommended for **approval** subject to the recommended changes to the wording of Condition G16.

How community views were taken into account:

The application was not required to be notified in accordance with Section 3.4.2 of the North Sydney Community Participation Plan as the proposed amendments to Condition G16 will have no environmental impact as the landscaping works will still be required to be completed prior to the issue of the final Occupation Certificate.

The conditions attached to the original consent for Development Application No. 102/16 by endorsed date of 21 September 2016 still apply.

ADVISINGS

- (a) Council is always prepared to discuss its decisions and in this regard, please do not hesitate to contact **the undersigned**. However, if you wish to pursue your rights of appeal in the Land and Environmental Court pursuant to Section 8.7 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 (as amended), you are advised that Council generally seeks resolution of such appeals through a Section 34 Conference, instead of a full Court hearing, subject to any further advice to the contrary from Council's Solicitors and senior staff. Such an approach is less adversarial, it achieves a quicker decision than would be the case through a Court hearing and it can give rise to considerable cost and time savings for all parties involved.
- (b) Pursuant to Section 8.2, an applicant is able to request Council to review its determination. An application for a review under Section 8.2 of the Act must be made no later than 28 days after the date on which the application for the modification of the development consent was determined.
- (c) Prior to commencing any building, subdivision or associated constructions works, the following provisions of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 (the 'Act') are to be complied with:
 - (i) A Construction Certificate is to be obtained in accordance with Section 6.3 of the Act.
 - (ii) A Principal Certifier is to be appointed and Council is to be notified of the appointment in accordance with Section 6.6 of the Act.

- (iii) Council is to be notified at least two (2) days of the intention to commence building works, in accordance with Section 6.6(2)(a) of the Act.
- (d) You are advised that changes to the external configuration of the building, changes to the site layout, density and unit configuration internal changes to the proposed building or any changes to the proposed operation of a use **MAY** require the submission of a further modification under Section 4.56 of the Environmental Planning & Assessment Act, 1979 (as amended).
