1	East Lane,	Hayberry, Wollstonecraft	Residents of East Lane have requested Council to: 1. Convert Eden Lane to One-Way traffic out to Pacific Highway, from West Lane to Pacific Highway. 2. Remove the existing kerb at the corner of Eden Street and Eden lane and provide Bollard to protect the substation to allow more travel lane in Eden Lane.	1. Council's traffic Engineer has investigated the proposed "One Way" traffic in Eden Street. Site visits revealed that there are 9 vehicles exiting Eden Street into Pacific Highway and 12 vehicles entering Eden Street from Pacific Highway in one-hour period in the morning. Further investigation revealed that there are 9 vehicles exiting Eden Street into Pacific Highway and no vehicle entered Eden Street from Pacific Highway in one-hour period in the afternoon. This demonstrates a very low traffic volume in Eden Street. 2. East lane is a "No Through" traffic laneway with local traffic. No Parking restrictions will be re-instated on the eastern side of East Lane once the building works are completed in East Lane. It appears that the kerb extension has been constructed as a preventative measure for the sub-station and vehicles parked in the No Parking zone for drop off/pick up in East Lane. It also provides a slow point at the entry to the East Lane from Eden Street. It also appears that the current issue is turning large trucks accessing the building sites which will be eliminated once the building works are complete.	1. THAT Council reviews the One Way proposal for East Lane in 12 months' time once the two developments are complete and traffic generated by these developments can be measured. 2. THAT the existing kerb alignment at the corner of Eden Street and Eden Lane be retained for protection of the substation and the parked vehicles in the No Parking zone.	N/A	N/A	(IM)
