2017	1	Ernest Street, Camberay	Registry, Tunks	10/2/17	<p>Anzac Park Public School has requested a 40km/h School Zone on Ernest Street adjacent to the school.</p> <p>At the Traffic Committee meeting on 16/6/17 it was recommended that this be included as a Standing Item on future Traffic Committee agendas.</p>	<p>RMS wrote to Council regarding the pedestrian refuge on Ernest Street at Anzac Avenue. A design to replace this refuge with a new and larger refuge to the east of Lytton Street has been prepared. RMS has indicated that funding may be available in 2018/19 financial year and works are scheduled to commence in April school holidays. Design drawings are being prepared for the conversion of the mid-block pedestrian crossing on Anzac Avenue outside the School to a raised crossing.</p> <p>At the Traffic Committee meeting on 20/10/17 it was recommended: THAT the Mayor write to the Roads Minister outlining the background of the speed zone on Ernest Street and requesting a site meeting with the Mayor, Anzac Park Public School Principal, Anzac Park Public School P&C representative, and to seek guidance on varying the guidelines to accommodate the genuine and legitimate request to provide a 40km/h School Zone on Ernest Street. A copy of the letter to be sent to the Education Minister, Premier, and Local MP</p> <p>This recommendation was subsequently adopted at the Council meeting on 30/10/17.</p> <p>The RMS has undertaken a further review of the School Zones around Anzac Park Public School. The 40km/h School zone will be installed in Ernest Street for a length of 225 metres, starting east of Miller Street. The signage and pavement markings will be installed during the April school holidays ready for Term 2.</p>	6869622 7125003
