LOOK AT THE WORLD AROUND YOU!

When playing the game ask children to stop, look and describe an object, place or activity that has held special meaning for them/your family through all the changes to day to day life in recent times.

Maybe they have discovered something new about?

Maybe it has changed recently?

Maybe it's a new aspect of their/your family's routine?

Looking and feeling stage

You might like to ask children the following questions:

WHAT DO YOU SEE? **WHAT DO YOU HEAR?**

WHAT DO YOU TASTE? **WHAT DO YOU SMELL?**

WHAT CAN YOU TOUCH?

HOW DOES IT MAKE YOU FEEL?

HAS IT CHANGED? HOW?

CAN YOU TELL A STORY ABOUT IT?

Artmaking stage

Ask children to express what they see and feel about their chosen object, place or activity through artmaking.

Children might like to explore:

SCULPTURE

Specifications for Instagram display

- Preferred file types .mp4 and .mov however you can send us most types
- Maximum file size 15MB
- Maximum file length 50 seconds

Specifications for You Tube display

- Preferred file types .mp4 and .mov however you can send us most types
- Maximum file size 500MB
- Maximum video length 50 seconds

Image files

Specifications for Instagram display

- Preferred file types .jpeg .jpg .tiff .ai .eps .psd however you can send us most types!
- Maximum file size 30MB
- Ideal dimensions:
 - Square: 1080 pixels wide x 1080 pixels high
 - Landscape: 1080 pixels wide x 608 pixels high
 - Portrait: 1080 pixels wide x 1350 high
