

North Sydney Council Noticeboard Program 2022



North Sydney Council maintains 60 community noticeboards throughout the area as a free service to promote local community services and special events. Council gives priority to local Community Events and non-profit groups and services.

Instructions for applying to promote your Community Event:

1. Contact the Community Information Officer at North Sydney Council (details at bottom of page) to book your space and make a note of the deadline. NOTE: If bookings are busy you might only be placed in 30 boards, or the boards may be fully booked.
2. Email a proof of the flyer to the Community Information Officer for approval.
3. When confirmation is received, deliver 30 or 60 x hard copies of flyers of the agreed size to the attention of the Community Information Officer either in person at Customer Service, 200 Miller Street, or by post to North Sydney Council, PO Box 12, North Sydney 2059. Notices are placed the weekend following the closing date.
4. Remember that it is your responsibility to make sure that hard copies of the flyers are delivered before 12pm midday on the closing date.



There are more options for displaying your flyers if you do not fit the criteria or if the noticeboard program is fully booked:

1. McMahons Point Community Centre, Blues Point Road (open board)
2. Opposite Waverton train station, Bay Road (open board)
3. Burton Street Tunnel, near Milsons Point train station (open board)
4. Civic Park Noticeboards - contact the Community Information Officer (details below)
