Outcome

- 1) RTA spokesman addressed the group as follows:
 - Estimated cost of the wall would be \$500 per sq metre @ 4 metres high = \$2000 per metre in additional there would be traffic control costs.
 - Project funding The left over funds from the bus layover project were redirected to a similar project.
 - Description of RTA funding program:
 - Projects obtain funds. The need for a noise wall is part of the EIS for the project.
 - NAP is separately funded.
 - NAP should look at these disparities when there are circumstances that increase traffic.

- 2) Residents requested a noise reading so that they can get on to the NAP.
RTA response:
 - RTA are reviewing the priority of NAP projects. They are also reviewing the overall funding of the program.
 - NAP only covers up to 2 stories.
